



CARE OF THE AVANT QUARTZ STONE PRODUCTS

Daily care

For daily care of the Avant Quartz quartz stone products, water and mild detergents, impregnated high-quality wipes, and non-abrasive sponge are used.

In general, it is recommended to use detergents with pH within the range from 5 to 9. Products with a higher or lower pH may cause damage of the surface, so you need first check their effect on small or invisible area.

It is not recommended to leave detergents on the surface for more than 5 minutes. If it is necessary to leave the detergent for more time, first check the result on small and invisible area of the surface.

Do not use detergents containing trichloroethane or methylene chloride (e.g. such as spot remover or cleaner).

If the surface is exposed to any potential dangerous substance, immediately wash it with water to neutralize destructive effect.

Do not allow contamination and smudges to stay on the surface of the Avant Quartz for a long time. Immediately carefully remove smudges.

Carefully wash used wipes and sponges after cleaning up.

High-temperature exposure

Avant Quartz surfaces tolerate short-term exposure of high temperatures. Long-term contact with very hot things may cause some damage.

To prevent this, be sure to use heat trivets.

Scratch resistance

Avant Quartz surfaces are highly scratch resistant. However, avoid using sharp objects such as sharp knives or screwdrivers directly on Avant Quartz surfaces.

Removing of stubborn stains and traces of fluids

Avant Quartz surfaces are highly resistant to stains. Stains are usually easily removed.

Before you begin to remove the stains as described below, try to remove it with a moisturized soft wiping cloth and soapy water or non-abrasive household detergent.

To remove stubborn dirt such as food, chewing gum, nail polish, or dried paint, first carefully scrape it off with a sharp scraper, and then use special mean.

Removing of organic dirt

To remove organic dirt use Cif® gel for cleaning bathroom or the analogue.

To remove chemical dirt use mild alcohol-containing degreaser or alcohol.
